### DESCRIPTION

Spring is the best time for "Figl". When the snow becomes scarce and soft and thus no longer ideal for skiing – then the figl time begins! They are just right for this kind of snow!

Figl are short ski-like plates and were invented by a native of Innsbruck, Emo Johann Heinrich.

You don't need much equipment for this spring sport. Depending on the type of Figl, all you need are good hiking boots or ski boots, Figl and winter clothing.

With the Figl you then go down the mountain. The special length allows you to brake or accelerate abruptly. Action and fun are not neglected here!

Figl-sport is a legendary highlight in the spring calendar, especially on the Nordkette in Innsbruck.

## **HOW TO FIX**



Original Figl with universal binding.



Ankle-high hiking boots are best suited for the universal binding

Open the lacing generously and place your foot in the binding. Slide all the way forward to stand well on the Figl. Next, lace up the binding very well!



The straps must also be tied tightly at the heel. To do this, fix your hiking boot to the binding using the "hooks" and thread the cords through. Tie a knot at the heel to secure everything.
