Spring is the best time for "Figl". When the snow becomes scarce and soft and thus no longer ideal for skiing – then the figl time begins! They are just right for this kind of snow!

Figl are short ski-like plates and were invented by a native of Innsbruck, Emo Johann Heinrich.

You don't need much equipment for this spring sport. Depending on the type of Figl, all you need are good hiking boots or ski boots, Figl and winter clothing.

With the Figl you then go down the mountain. The special length allows you to brake or accelerate abruptly. Action and fun are not neglected here!

Figl-sport is a legendary highlight in the spring calendar, especially on the Nordkette in Innsbruck.

# **HOW TO FIX**



Original Figl with plate binding.



First open the fastening for the shoes and adjust the plate binding to your shoe size. There is a slider on the binding to change the size.



Ski boots are best suited for the plate binding. So put on your ski boots and put your feet in the middle of the binding. Close the binding and fasten the strap to fix everything.



If the binding is set correctly, it should now look like this picture.
